






Children under 6 years old in Allen County¹









Public school students receiving free or reduced lunches in Allen County⁵



Licensed Family Child Care programs Allen County⁶-**92 in priority ZIP codes⁶**





Early childcare programs participating in Paths to Quality in Allen County¹ - 81 in priority ZIP codes⁶








Early childcare programs certified as Paths to Quality Level 3 or 4 in Allen County¹ -36 in priority ZIP codes⁶

Children under 6 years old enrolled in early childcare programs in Allen County¹






Approximate number of children under the age of 6 in Allen County who are not enrolled in needed care ¹




Children under 6 years old enrolled in Family Child Care in Allen County¹






Third grade children proficient in reading in the Fort Wayne Community School Corporation⁷






Children in grades 3-8 proficient in mathematics in the Fort Wayne Community School Corporation⁷










Infant deaths in Allen County from 2016-20208



*Perinatal risks are conditions that originate during pregnancy, during the birth process, or shortly after birth that affect the infant's health







46806 Outcomes At-A-Glance from 2016-20208:

- Infant deaths occurred at more than double the rate of other priority ZIP codes
- SUID rate was double the rate of other priority ZIP codes
- Perinatal risk rate was significantly higher than that of other priority ZIP codes
- Average perinatal risk deaths occurred at triple the rate of other priority ZIP codes




Grassroots MCH / ECA Collaborative Priority ZIP Code Provider Distribution







